Introduction to 2025 Artificial Intelligence and Sustainability Programme

Of Zhi-Xing China: Global Youth Leadership Fellowships

To enhance dialogue and friendship between Chinese and foreign youth, deepen young people's understanding of China, and cultivate future leaders who will promote global friendship, peace and sustainable development, the China Education Association for International Exchange has launched "Zhi-Xing China: Global Youth Leadership Fellowships", providing a diverse platform for young people worldwide to showcase their talents and engage in exchange and dialogue.

In 2025, the programme, hosted by Xidian University, will focus on the theme of "Artificial Intelligence and Sustainable Development." The project will invite 30 outstanding young leaders (25 international and 5 Chinese) to visit and study in Xi'an and Beijing from June 29 to July 8. In the lectures, roundtable discussions, corporate visits and cultural activities, participants will gain insights into China's political and economic landscape, traditional culture and modern technological advancements. They will also explore AI technologies and applications while discovering China's efforts in sustainable development.

The following expenses are included in this programme:

- 1. Domestic transportation within China, including:
 - (1) Airport pickup in Xi'an, China
 - (2) Airport drop-off in Beijing, China
 - (3) Domestic transportation from Xi'an to Beijing via high-speed rail, including pickup and drop-off
 - (4) All transportation during the scheduled itinerary
- 2. Hotel accommodation
- 3. Meals: Three meals per day as included in the itinerary
- 4. Admission fees for all scheduled attractions listed in the itinerary

The following expenses are not included in this programme:

- 1. Transportation: Domestic transport within New Zealand and flights between New Zealand and China
- 2. International travel insurance
- 3. Any meals and transportation outside the itinerary due to personal reasons

4. Any additional expenses caused by personal decisions, force majeure or unforeseen circumstances

New Zealand Participants:

- 1) This programme offers up to **Ten spots** for New Zealand **Tertiary Students**.
- 2) The application deadline is 20 May 2025.
- 3) **Eligibility:** Applicants must be New Zealand citizens over 18 years of age and currently serving in student organizations.
 - Note: New Zealand citizens (New Zealand passport holders) are eligible under the China visa exemption policy, and are not required to apply for Chinese visa.
- 4) **Application documents:** (a) the personal information page of a valid ID (passport page is preferred); (b) a resume (including a permanent email address, mobile phone number, current title in the student organization, etc.); (c) a personal statement outlining the reasons for the application.

- 6) The organizing team will evaluate the applications. A face-to-face or video interview may be required. The results will be notified by email on or before 23 **May 2025**.
